LENOIR'S WATER AND SEWER
ORDINANCES WITHIN THE
CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE
TOWN OF HUDSON**

WHEREAS, as a result of the agreement between the Town of Hudson and the City of Lenoir dated August 5, 1999, the City of Lenoir owns and operates the water and sewer system within the corporate boundaries of the Town of Hudson; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lenoir has Water and Sewer Ordinances in place to govern the operation of their Water and Sewer System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, NORTH CAROLINA, that the Town of Hudson officially adopts the City of Lenoir's Water and Sewer Ordinances and replaces the Town of Hudson's Water and Sewer Ordinances as stated under *Chapter 6 – Municipal Utilities Article 1 and Article 2* in the Town of Hudson's Code of Ordinances with the Water and Sewer Ordinances for the City of Lenoir; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Town of Hudson, by and through its duly elected Board of Commissioners, permits the duly designated officials of the Town of Hudson to enforce, within the Town of Hudson, Lenoir's Water and Sewer Ordinances as the Ordinances may be modified or amended from time to time.

ARTICLE 4

Cable Television

Section 6.38 Regulation of basic service tier rates and related equipment, installation and service charges.

(a) The Town will follow the FCC Rate Regulations in its regulation of the Basic Service Rates and Charges of the Company and any other cable television operating in the Town, notwithstanding any different or inconsistent provisions in the Franchise; and

(b) In connection with such regulation, the Town will ensure a reasonable opportunity for consideration of the views of interested parties; and

(c) The Town Manager or his or her designee, is authorized to execute on behalf of the Town and file with the FCC such certification forms or other instruments as are now or may hereafter be required by the FCC Rate Regulations in order to enable the Town to regulate Basic Service Rates and Charges.
