

Minutes of Recreation Committee Meeting
Monday, March 9, 2020

- Chapman called the meeting to order.
- Approved minutes of the last meeting.
- Allen Stewart went over the plans he has drawn for the Concession/Press Box building at the Optimist Park. He advised the group he had been in contact with the County Building Inspectors, Brushy Mountain Builders, Chuck and Rebecca as he developed the plans. The topography poses a significant obstacle as he designs the building. The building is a three story structure of block and plywood with a metal roof and metal sheathing. There will be a wainscoting of the front of the concessions stand made from split face block left from the construction of the recreation center. The bottom level is storage with a garage door and an entry door. The ground level is the 12x16 concession area, a men's restroom and a women's restroom. They will be a 3" concrete floor on metal joists on the ground level. There will be a separate entry door to the concession area and another separate entry door to the stairway upstairs. The floor will have floor drains for ease of cleaning. The women's restroom will have two stalls and a sink, the men's room will have a stall and a urinal and a sink. Each is ADA accessible. Per the building code, in order to avoid the need for an elevator the area has to be less than 500' square footage and the ceiling must be 12'. The stair will lead from the ground level to the upper level which will have windows on the front and side in order to have clear view of the playing fields. The building will be heated and cooled. Allen asked for suggestions from the group for changes. Everyone seemed pleased with the plans. Allen will take the plans back and get them ready for submission to the full board.
- Chuck reviewed the fundraising. Baker Tire and RPM have donated \$5,000 for naming rights to dugouts. To date about 40 bricks have been sold.
- Next meeting is April 13, 2020
