Commissioner Chapman called the meeting to order.

Discussion of Previous Meetings

Chuck Raby asked if anyone had anything they would like to discuss from previous meeting.

Commissioner Larry Chapman asked if we were still holding the annual Easter Egg Hunt and that Hudson Community Development will give \$400 towards that if it's enough.

Chuck Raby said we are having the annual egg hunt and \$400 is fine.

Proposed Pool Schedule

Chuck Raby discussed the proposed pool schedule (attached). The new schedule aligns with weekly pool usage. The hours of operation and days for public swim more closely align with when we see the most usage. We have also had difficulty finding enough life guards. Cutting some days and hours helps with scheduling.

Chuck Raby discussed new fees for 2023. Daycare rate will increase to \$3/child from \$2. Pool rentals will increase from \$150 to \$175. Lifeguard pay for rentals remains \$10/hour per guard. General admission remains \$5 per person.

Commissioner Jeff Link made the motion to approve the schedule and fees. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Jim Engelman and approved by committee.

50th Anniversary

Chuck Raby passed out "50th Anniversary" magnets to the committee. He also discussed activities to date such as poster give away and putting 50th anniversary logo on all sports team's jerseys/shirts.

Chuck Raby reminded the group that February is social media month. Each week a different prize will be given away at random to those that interact with Hudson Parks & Recreation's Facebook page/posts. Giveaways will include 50th anniversary t-shirt, gym membership, and free participation in a youth program.

Chuck Raby said in March we will give away t-shirts to those that correctly answer trivia questions. During the Easter Egg hunt there will be 50 grand prize eggs for each age group. Those prizes will be different sports equipment and board games.

Jon Greer said we are starting to work on a bigger event for August and may use "Events in the Park" to help execute that.

Optimist Park

Chuck Raby said we need rain to stop and he is pushing contractors to complete the remaining work. Fencing installation has begun and Blue Ridge Energy is waiting on dry weather to install new poles for lighting. The power box has been installed for Duke Energy. Once Duke runs the new power line, concrete can be poured. Two larger concrete contractors have been contacted to complete the job when needed. May is still a realistic finish date.

Chuck Raby said we are trying to tie the grand opening with the opening of baseball season which will near the end of April or beginning of May.

Other Discussion

Commissioner Jeff Link said CCC&TI has been discussing with Chuck Raby the possibility of moving softball games from Lenoir to Hudson's Optimist Park once its complete. Softball would not interfere with recreation's baseball schedule.

Commissioner Link said the Town may need to make a formal invitation to the college to have softball play in Hudson. He will update as the discussion progresses.

Motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Link and seconded by Commissioner Jim Engelman. Motion approved.
